

"Because Science Has Disproved Christianity!" (Part 2)

John 20:24-29 (HCSB)

But one of the Twelve, Thomas (called "Twin"), was not with them when Jesus came. ²⁵ So the other disciples kept telling him, "We have seen the Lord!" But he said to them, "If I don't see the mark of the nails in His hands, put my finger into the mark of the nails, and put my hand into His side, I will never believe!" ²⁶ After eight days His disciples were indoors again, and Thomas was with them. Even though the doors were locked, Jesus came and stood among them. He said, "Peace to you!" ²⁷ Then He said to Thomas, "Put your finger here and observe My hands. Reach out your hand and put it into My side. Don't be an unbeliever, but a believer." ²⁸ Thomas responded to Him, "My Lord and my God!" ²⁹ Jesus said, "Because you have seen Me, you have believed. Those who believe without seeing are blessed."

Week #2: Learning to doubt your doubts:

- I. The question of the origin of the universe.
 - No scientist believes evolution explains the origin of the universe.

• The attributes of God found in the scriptures clearly distinguish <u>God</u> as the noncontingent creator. (Psalm 90:1-2; John 5:26)

2. The problem of human rights in an accidental universe.

- Sociology reveals a <u>universal</u> standard of behavior in all people, regardless of their culture, religion or period in history.
- Since a universal moral code exists, where did it originate?
- The skeptics final arrow only points them to God. (Micah 6:8)
- 3. The persistence of Christianity. (Matthew 16:18)
- 4. The prophecies of the Old Testament. (II Peter 1:21)
 - Over <u>3,000</u> fulfilled prophecies are found in scripture, you can make a case just from prophecy alone on the inspiration of scripture.
 - Jesus fulfilled over 300 prophecies in his birth, life, ministry, death and resurrection.
 - There have been over <u>25,000</u> archeological discoveries that have validated the accuracy of scripture in what it reports.
- 5. The historical evidence for the resurrection. (1 Corinthians 15:1-8)
- 6. The completely unique message of Christianity. (Isaiah 53:5)
