- 3. Because it's in my best interest! (Ephesians 6:1-3)

- Submitting to authority is life's first and most foundational lesson.
- Maximum freedom comes in submission to authority.

II. How we honor:

- I. As a I child I honor by obedience. (Colossians 3:20; Ephesians 6:1)
- 2. As a young adult I honor them by respecting them.
- We show respect with our words. (1 Timothy 5:1-2)
- We show respect as we listen. (Proverbs 23:22)
- · We show respect as we defer!
- 3. As an adult I honor my parents by caring for them. (John 19:26-27)
- We show honor by taking our turn in the care cycle!
