Hello, everyone! Thank you for your interest in joining the Worship Team! Below is what to expect and what to prepare for Worship Team Auditions!

Q: What do I wear? Dress as you would to lead for a Sunday service!

Q: What do I bring?

• Acoustic Guitar & Bass Guitar: Bring your instrument, picks, capo (if needed), and earbuds/In-ears.

• <u>Lead Electric Guitar & Rhythm Electric Guitar</u>: Bring your instrument, picks, capo (if needed), your pedal board, and earbuds/In-ears.

- Drums: You will use our drum kit. Bring your sticks and ear buds/In-ears.
- <u>Piano/Keys</u>: You will use our keyboard. Bring earbuds/In-ears.
- <u>Vocalists</u>: Bring earbuds/In-ears.

Q: What kind of earbuds/In-ears should I bring? Any earbuds/In-ear monitors that have a 3.5mm/1/8" jack. No Wireless/bluetooth or lightening cables.

Q: What songs do l prepare? We will email you a dropbox folder with 4-5 songs (mp3's, charts, & lyrics) about a week before your audition date. This will be similar to a regular serving experience.

Q: Do I need to bring printed music or lyrics? For instruments, we will have number charts printed for you. For vocals, we will have lyrics on the back wall (confidence monitor).

Q: What time is my audition?

• When you register, you will specify your preferred window of time to audition. We will do our best to accommodate and will follow up with you the week of your audition with your official window.

• You will be called at random and your specific audition will take 5-10 minutes. After your audition, you will be free to leave and we will be in touch within the next few days to schedule a 1-on-1 meeting with a Staff Worship Leader. We will talk feedback during this time and talk about your next steps. Allow 10-15 minutes for your 1-on-1 meeting.

Q: Where do I go when I arrive? Head into the Atrium of the Worship Center at our Battlefield Campus. Enter where you see the big orange flags outside! Check in is at the table in the Atrium.

Q: Can I audition for just one specific ministry? We have two campuses and many ministries. Everyone who joins our team, joins with the understanding that you may be scheduled to lead worship within any of them as needed. We trust you to accept or decline according to your margin and availability.

Q: What is the time commitment for rehearsals and services? Time commitment varies depending one which ministry and/or campus you are serving at. Rehearsals are held on the same day, immediately before service(s), and are 1-2 hours long.
